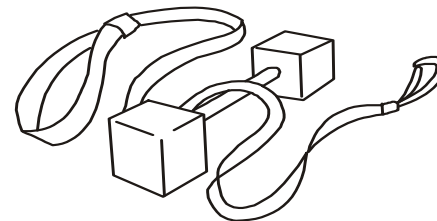

Move Up Regulations

If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice MUST be given to Trial Secretary no later than 6 PM on Monday, June 7, 2010. Move-ups will be accommodated from Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday at the trial. No verbal changes will be accepted.

Refunds

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season will be awarded a refund (with a Veterinary Certificate), less \$10 processing fee per day.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number. Open to mix breeds Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance, are not eligible.

Liability

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Countryside Agility, WLTC and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children

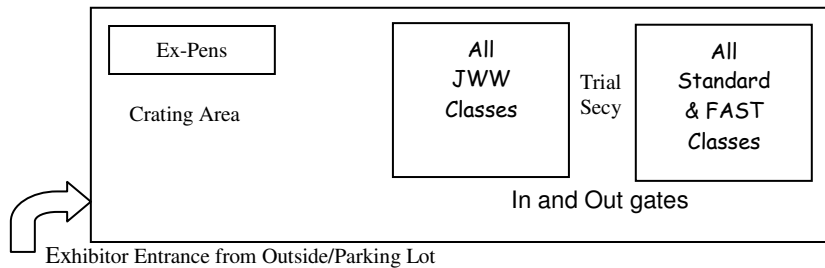

The entire room is "turfed" so we ask that you strictly adhere to the following rules in order that we may keep the site for future trials.

- ◆ Building available for exhibitor set-up on Thursday night from 5pm to 9pm only.
- ◆ Plastic / tarp / rugs must be placed under all crates, ex-pens, chairs and water bowls. Ex-pens for 3 or more dogs allowed in special set-up area only.
- ◆ No straight-legged chairs allowed on soccer turf.
- ◆ No gum, candy, food or beverages (other than water) allowed on soccer turf. Food will be available on site, but must be eaten in specified dining area only.
- ◆ Failure to clean up after dogs ANYWHERE will result in a \$25 fine.
- ◆ NO grooming allowed in the North Amherst Recreation Center.
- ◆ Crating space is limited. Exhibitors should consolidate their crating area or they might be asked to do so by the Trial Chairman. Some overflow crating areas are available elsewhere in the building. No unentered dogs, please!
- ◆ Due to limited parking space, there will be no RV's, motor homes, or overnight camping allowed.
- ◆ Only crates and personal property may be left in building overnight. No dogs will be allowed to remain in the building overnight. The building will be locked after show hours.
- ◆ Dogs MUST be on leash at all times ... unless competing or warming up.
- ◆ REMEMBER ... In order to keep this beautiful site, we must keep it CLEAN at all times ... this means both INSIDE and OUTSIDE. Please stoop and scoop at the HOTELS, too! We thank you.
